

Beware of ATM/Debit **Card Skimming!**

What you can do to help avoid ATM fraud

- Keep PIN codes safe and never reveal your PIN to anyone
- If an ATM has unusual signage, don't use it. No bank would ever hang a sign saying "Swipe your card here before using the ATM", or anything to that effect
- Look at the ATM before you use it. If it doesn't look right don't use it and make sure you report it to us by calling 800-856-0026 for the St. Johnsbury Office or 800-370-6455 for the Littleton Office or the after hour's number 800-528-2273 to report it as Lost or Stolen.
- Be wary of anyone offering "help" at an ATM
- Be wary of others observing you, or looking over your shoulder
- When you enter your PIN use your hand to block anyone from seeing which numbers you use
- If your card is not returned after your transaction is complete, or after pressing cancel, immediately contact the institution which issued it
- Remember to take your card with you when you leave the ATM
- Always check your bank statements to be sure there are no unusual transactions
